Discussion

- I. **Call to Order and Introductions.** Mary Anne Ford chaired the meeting and welcomed attendees.
- II. **Approval of Minutes.** The minutes from the meeting of May 25, 2017, were unanimously approved.
- III. **Focus Groups:**
 - a. **Residents:** Mary Anne Ford informed the group that AI Fusion has private space and availability for a focus group and dinner on July 20. If this is acceptable, we can confirm the date with the restaurant and distribute invitations. Mary Anne will send a note of invitation for the GME directors to share with potential attendees. Potential Focus Group Discussion Topics were shared with the Committee and members offered several suggestions:
 - i. Program Directors will be able to provide information needed to complete a profile of the participants.
 - ii. Ask if there is anything they would do differently in identifying preferred residency locations and preparing to apply.
 - iii. Add financial resources to question about priorities in choosing where to practice
 - iv. Ask if their residency is a good fit for them.
- IV. **Data on Retention from GME Programs.** Sheri Clarke shared information from McLaren Greater Lansing for 2016 and information from Sparrow/MSU for 2014 and 2015. Committee members were enthused about having data that is specific to our area and that could be used to identify progress in retention of residents. The two data reports were different in format and content, and everyone agreed that it would be helpful to get the same content from everyone. Items included in the McLaren 2016 report that committee members thought would be helpful included:
 - a. Information about the residents who did not stay at the residency site. This would include the number who remained in the referring area, the number who stayed in Michigan, but not in Greater Lansing and the number who left the state.

- V. Details on the residents' choices. The list from McLaren offers a glimpse into competing communities in Michigan and provides some hints about the priorities and interests that might have driven their decisions.
- VI. **Benefits of Greater Lansing.** CAHA will be working on a draft for review in September.
- VII. **Next CAPE Meeting:**
 - a. There will be no meeting in July or August.
 - b. Our next meeting will be September 14, and will be held on the 2nd Thursday of each month moving forward.
