TOPIC: Are Healthcare Employers Leaving Money on the Table?

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Administrators, Managers, Human Resources, Nurse Directors and Educators from Hospitals, Long Term, Continuing and Home Care Settings, Hospice, Ambulatory Care Clinics and Private Physician Practice Groups

The healthcare apprenticeship model of training staff in hospitals, care facilities, outpatient clinics, and physician offices offers advantages to both employers and employees. The data show that employees who are trained in the apprenticeship model have higher retention rates. The US Department of Labor indicates that the employer return on investment in the apprenticeship training model is \$28 of benefit for \$1 expended on training.

This information session is offered to:

- Introduce employers to the healthcare apprenticeship model
- Share information about potential state and federal resources to support employers in implementing an apprenticeship program
- Provide an opportunity for questions and discussion
- Solicit interest in collaborating in a Capital Area project to implement an apprenticeship program

There will also be discussion of a similar healthcare apprenticeship project that has been initiated in the Grand Rapids area.
